



How to Make a Paper Mosaic

Instructions

Step One: Print out an ADA Cleveland Call for Access template or draw out your own on a piece of paper.

Step Two: Rip up colored paper in the colors you would like to use into small pieces (about ½ inch to 1 inch).

Step Three: Glue the small pieces of colored paper onto your template to create a beautiful picture!
